The Commodore's Comments - Commodore David Herbold

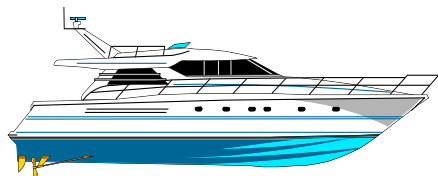
Well finally some nice weather! Boats are slowly going in the water. It seems like everyone is behind the eight ball. It has been tough to get anything done with the weather in

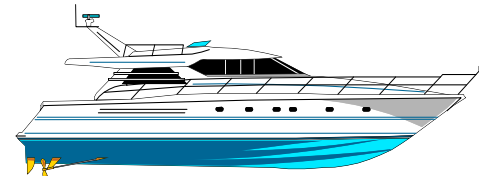
We plan on having a modified Flag Raising on June 7th at 11am, It's not going to be the usual ceremony though.
