This pandemic summer is going fast, even though there hasn't be much to do. Thankfully we have boating. The members at IHYC have been out a lot so far this year. We

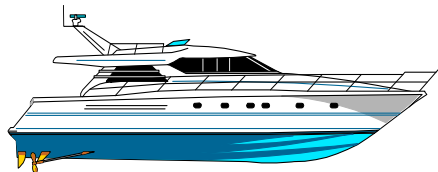
had a 26 boat raft off at the cove recently. I believe about 15 boats stayed overnight. It was a great time and as always all members are welcome.

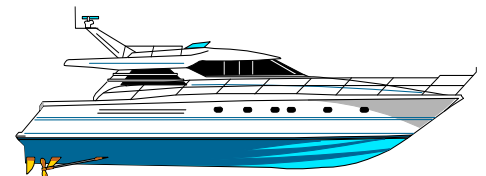
