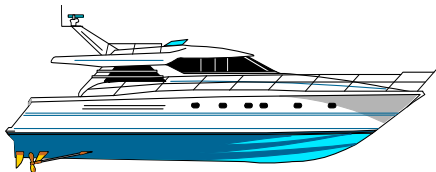
month. Everyone enjoyed the fish and a few people ate outside under the tent which was set up for the band and bbq.

Since there will be no Commodores or Vice

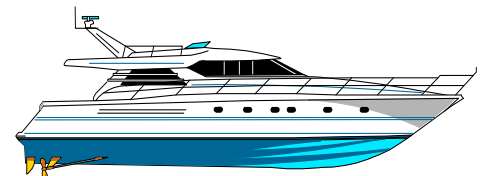
